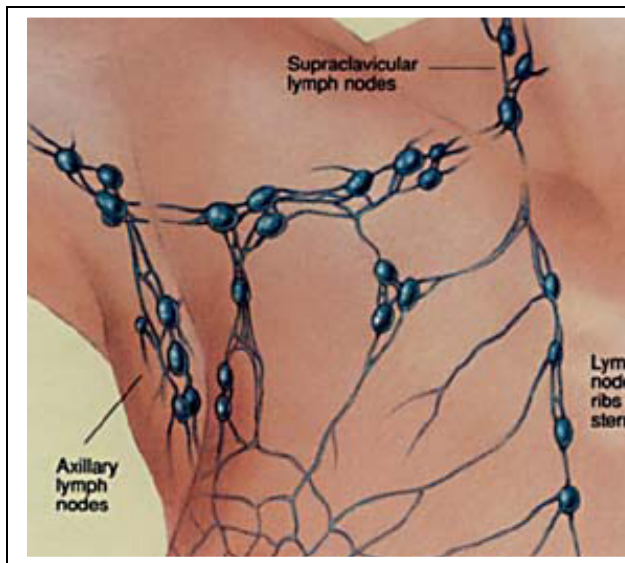

Coming up this Friday: Jennifer Acree, the BEST project

Last Friday Dr. Markus Zuber, a surgical oncologist, shared his research about the surgical aspects of Early Breast Cancer Management within European clinical trials. Dr. Zuber, of Basel, Switzerland, pioneered the techniques of sentinel lymph node mapping in breast and colon cancer and lead the first multicenter trial in his home country. He explained his research methodologies and results. According to Dr. Zuber, the lymph nodes are the most important marker for breast cancer. Dissecting the lymph nodes to detect cancer has been controversial because the procedure is very invasive.

Zuber researched a less invasive procedure called positron emissions tomography, or PET, and found the results were not as good as doctors had hoped. PET turned out to not be an effective or accurate method for detecting lymphomic metasis for breast cancer, according to Zuber, “PET not yet,” is how he phrased it.

Zuber was in Flint to participate in the International Perspectives in Breast & Gastrointestinal Cancer for The 21st Century conference at McLaren Regional Medical Center.
