From the November 7th meeting:

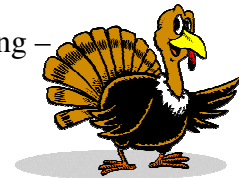
1. It pays to come early. Dick Ebbott joined Paul Vanstrom for a wonderful rendition of Memories from Cats.
