Dallas will talk about his vision for Carriage Town Ministries.



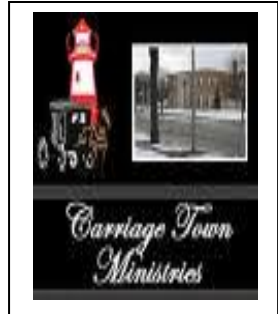

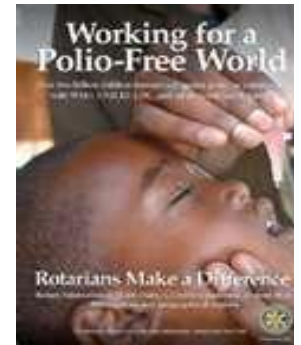

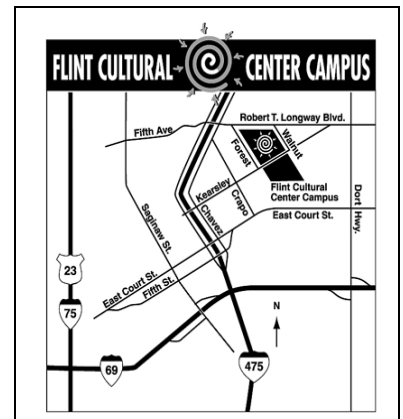
